

AGREEMENT

Of course, anytime you have pets (or humans) together in one place, there are risks involved. They can hurt themselves in vigorous play, get into fights, get over-excited and get an upset stomach, or get sick. We, at Arfington Pet Resort, are committed to minimizing the risks to your pet. We promise to supervise every aspect of your pets stay, diligently attend to sanitation and hygiene, and everything else we can possibly do to mitigate the potential for any harm. However, no amount of prevention will eliminate the risks completely.

There are some things you should be aware of before you make the decision to leave your pet in our (or any) facility. Please read and initial each item below, so we know you have had the chance to review:

_____ Pets who engage in a different level of activity while at Arfington than they are accustomed to at home, may experience mild soreness or fatigue.

_____ Pets who socialize with other pets (daycare dogs) may engage in rough and tumble play with others, and can sustain minor scrapes, scratches, or nips.

_____ Pets who socialize with others may get into a fight and can be injured.

_____ Pets not accustomed to being away from home may experience some separation anxiety.

_____ Pets who eat our food, "Life's Abundance", while with us, may experience some stomach discomfort (even diarrhea and vomiting) when they get home, if they are switched back to their regular food.

_____ Pets will be playing and having fun here and may get dirty. If they are boarding with us for 2 or more nights we will not send them home without a bath. Others may wish to order a pre-pick up bath for their pet.

_____ Infectious tracheobronchitis or "Canine Cough" is spread by an air-borne virus and can be contracted from a dog park, kennel, groomer, vet, or anywhere an infected dog may be. Although we require that all dogs that come to Arfington be vaccinated, there are some strains that are resistant. We will do everything in our power to prevent the spread of this virus, however, we cannot be held responsible for any medical treatment caused by airborne disease.

_____ Flea & tick prevention or baths applied at Arfington (if necessary or requested) will be effective for current infestations, but may not prevent future infestation if the pet comes in contact with fleas or ticks after leaving the facility.
